SESSION 12 - UN ORGANIZATIONS AND EDUCATION MONITORING

Data and monitoring approaches differ widely between UN agencies each tasked to monitor various facets at the intersection of education with the other sustainable development goals. Whilst cross fertilization and collaboration on data collection exists amongst different sectors more needs to be done to streamline data collection methodologies, avoid duplication of efforts and ensure the provision of consistent, credible data to policy makers and data users on all aspects of education.

Objectives:

Featuring representatives from different sectors with a stake in these areas the objective of this session is to learn from current education data collection and monitoring efforts across sectors and identify ways to harmonize approaches to ensure efficient and expansive coverage on all aspects of SDG 4.

The session will:

- 1. Introduce and learn from different education data and monitoring efforts across sectors as well as identify areas for increased collaboration;
- 2. Demonstrate the utility of new benchmark indicators in the ongoing efforts to collect data and monitor progress for specific interest groups.

Format:

Each speaker to provide a response to their allocated question lasting no more than five minutes. Speakers to limit the number of PPT slides to three and to make use of the PPT template provided.

The presentations to be followed by an interactive discussion to discuss ways for increased and improved collaboration on data collection and monitoring.
