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Expenditure indicators: What are the challenges going forward?

Expenditure indicators

- FFA Government expenditure on education as a percentage of GDP
- 1.a.2 Proportion of total government spending on essential services (education)
- 4.5.4 Expenditure on education per student by level of education and source of funding
- 4.5.6 Expenditure on education as a percentage of GDP by source of funding (public, private, international)



Coverage of SDG 4 expenditure indicators in terms of share of population (%)






Challenges (2)

Conflicting data sources for public expenditure

Public expenditure on education as share of total government expenditure by year and source, South Africa IMF and UIS data on education expenditure as share of total government expenditure by country using the same denominator





Challenges (3)

Private expenditure measurement

- Very few countries report household expenditure on education. Data additions are indirect estimates based on household survey reports.
- Despite the new data, coverage in recent years remains low and there are various limitations in data collected from household survey reports.
- Low coverage, low frequency and cross-survey comparability issues.



Agenda forward to work with Member States

Create menu of harmonization methods of FFA and SDG 1.a.2 indicators

- Simplify data collection instruments
 - Simplify or prioritize FFA and SDG 4 indicators
 - Provide clear guidelines to respondents on how to obtain the data needed to fill in the fields including the metadata
- Develop and provide guidelines to national statistical offices on how to collect household expenditure on education
- Simplify guidelines and expand national education accounts methodology



Proposed decision (1)

Expenditure data: challenges and solutions forward

- Noting the information presented in the report 'Education expenditure data: challenges and solutions forward' (1 UIS/EDS/6);
- acknowledging the three challenges associated with the calculation of expenditure indicators, namely:
 - low coverage, apart from total public expenditure;
 - conflicting data sources for public expenditure;
 - private expenditure data production.



Proposed decision (2) Expenditure data: challenges and solutions forward

The UNESCO Conference on Education Data and Statistics

requests the TCG/EDS commission to focus efforts on:

- Creating a menu of harmonization methods of the FFA and SDG 1.a.2 indicators
- Simplifying data collection instruments including prioritization
- Developing and providing guidelines to national statistical offices on how to collect household expenditure on education
- Simplifying guidelines and expanding the national education accounts methodology







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
